PUNGA is a well-kept 1998 Dufour 45 Classic for sale, offered in excellent condition and ready for blue-water or coastal cruising. Her sleek white fiberglass hull, clean non-slip deck, and dependable Volvo Penta MD22P engine with only 2,000 hours provide confidence on every passage.

Her navigation suite includes Raymarine chart plotters, autopilot, AIS, and a Hydrovane self-steering system. On deck, she carries an electric windlass, sprayhood, Bimini, deck shower, and a full Blue Sunbrella Isinglass enclosure. A Delta anchor, Plow anchor, and Para anchor support secure holding in varied conditions. For fun on the water, she includes a West Marine PHP 310 inflatable tender with a Mercury 5 hp outboard and a Decathlon paddleboard.

Below, the Dufour Classic 45 layout offers three double cabins, a saloon berth, two heads, and a proper navigation desk. Warm wood joinery, fabric upholstery, and 6'3" headroom create a welcoming interior. The galley features a two-burner stove, oven, BBQ grill, stainless steel sink, and a 12V fridge with an Isotherm ASU icebox.

Safety gear is extensive, with three fire extinguishers, eight life jackets, five electric bilge pumps, three manual pumps, an EPIRB, radar reflector, and a MOB system. Standing rigging was renewed in 2020. Sails include a 2022 storm jib and an asymmetrical spinnaker for broad performance across wind ranges.

Now ashore at A&J Baldacchino Boat Yard in Malta, this Dufour 45 Classic for sale comes with a proven cruising record from Florida to the Mediterranean. PUNGA is a strong match for sailors seeking comfort, reliability, and capable offshore performance. She is ready for her next owner.
