Blue Matisse is a versatile Southerly 115 designed by Dick Carter and built by Northshore Yachts. Her variable-draft lifting keel, solid GRP construction, and well-balanced hull create a confident cruiser for shallow anchorages and open coastal passages.

A Beta Marine 38hp engine, installed in 2008 and showing around 1,600 hours, provides dependable propulsion with a simple mechanical layout. Her straightforward sloop rig and practical sail wardrobe support relaxed, enjoyable cruising.

Below deck, the Southerly 115 layout offers two cabins, two heads, a functional navigation station, and a generous saloon. Warm teak joinery creates an inviting interior with clear potential for light modernisation. She would benefit from general TLC, yet remains an honest and promising platform for an owner looking to tailor her to their needs.

With a proven cruising record across the UK, the Azores, and the Mediterranean, *Blue Matisse* combines pedigree design with real potential for future adventures.
