Aquila is a special 40th Anniversary edition of the Dufour 385 Grand Large, first unveiled at the 2005 London Boat Show. This desirable model features the popular three-cabin, one-heads layout, offering a generous owner's cabin with a true double berth and additional storage.

As the official show boat, Dufour specified Aquila with an extensive range of factory-fitted extras. Consequently, she benefits from a higher level of equipment than many comparable examples. These upgrades continue to enhance comfort, usability, and overall cruising enjoyment.

Since 2011, the current owner has used Aquila exclusively as a private family cruising yacht. As a result, she delivers safe, fast, and predictable sailing in a wide range of conditions. At the same time, her bright interior and practical layout create a welcoming space both underway and alongside.

Throughout current ownership, Aquila has been based in Cardiff. From there, she has cruised widely across the Bristol Channel and the English Channel. In addition, she has visited the Channel Islands, Isles of Scilly, and the UK south coast. Beyond this, her cruising history includes Brittany, Ireland, and the west coast of Scotland, clearly demonstrating her offshore capability.
