Exclusively offered for sale through Williams & Smithells International Ltd, this 2017 Beneteau Oceanis 41.1 presents a superb opportunity to acquire a proven Mediterranean cruising yacht currently lying in Motril, Spain. Enjoyed for Mediterranean cruising only, she has seen light seasonal use by her current owners, with just three months in 2024 and three months in 2025, and has been stored ashore between owner visits. With no insurance claims made, a 2024 structural survey, and a specification that reflects careful ownership, she will particularly appeal to buyers seeking a modern production cruiser with comfort, pedigree and sensible ongoing maintenance.

Built with a white GRP hull and integrated non-slip deck, she features the popular twin-wheel steering layout, aft cockpit, iron fin keel and spade rudder that make the Oceanis 41.1 such a capable and rewarding yacht under sail. Power comes from the Yanmar 4JH45 45hp diesel engine with saildrive, supported by a fixed electric bowthruster, with notable recent works including a 2024 service, main gasket replacement, windlass motor rebuild, and a 2025 fresh-water flush and oil change. Below deck, the bright Alpi walnut interior offers a forward owner's cabin, two further heads with shower facilities, white leather upholstery, navigation desk, heating, and excellent headlining throughout, creating a welcoming and practical space for extended cruising. Her onboard systems are equally well set up, with all five AGM batteries professionally replaced in 2025, shore power, generous tankage, and a brand-new unused generator included in the sale.

On deck and afloat, she is equipped for relaxed Mediterranean living, with slab-reefed mainsail and furling genoa, Harken winches, sprayhood, bimini, sun awning, passarelle, deck shower, electric windlass and a well-rounded navigation suite including twin B&G Zeus W7 plotters, Simrad autopilot and Garmin VHF. The package is completed by a Koronakis Kinglight 270D tender with Yamaha 5hp four-stroke outboard, last serviced in January 2025. Combining Beneteau's renowned cruising design with a strong ownership record, attractive inventory and an appealing Spanish berth, this Oceanis 41.1 is a highly desirable yacht ready for her next owners' adventures.
