2003 Janmor 45CL | Well-Equipped Bluewater Cruiser for Sale

Launched in 2003 and built to an exacting standard, this Janmor 45CL is a capable bluewater cruiser with true long-range appeal. Designed by Krzysztof Mackowiak, she combines elegant lines with robust construction and a specification tailored for serious cruising. Her white GRP hull with subtle blue detailing gives her a timeless profile, while her proven pedigree makes her an excellent choice for extended passagemaking or life aboard.

Construction began in 2000 and she was commissioned in 2003. The result is a well-balanced yacht that delivers both sailing performance and cruising comfort. She has been thoughtfully upgraded over the years and presents as a highly practical offshore yacht with the equipment and systems needed for confident independent cruising.

Power comes from a reliable Yanmar 56hp diesel engine driving a 3-blade folding propeller. She also benefits from a generator, bow thruster, wind generator, and watermaker, giving her impressive autonomy at sea. With 430 litres of fuel and 760 litres of water, this Janmor 45CL is well suited to longer passages and extended time away from shore support.

Her sloop rig features a Sparcraft aluminium mast and updated standing rigging from 2019. The sail plan is both versatile and easy to manage, with an in-mast furling mainsail and multiple furling headsails. This setup supports short-handed cruising while still offering the flexibility and performance expected from a capable offshore yacht.

Navigation and communication systems are well specified for offshore work. Equipment from Raymarine, Furuno, and ICOM provides the confidence needed for coastal and bluewater passage planning. Every element of her inventory reflects a yacht prepared for real cruising rather than occasional weekend use.

Below deck, the interior is warm, practical, and inviting. Accommodation is arranged for up to five guests in three cabins, including a generous aft master suite with en-suite facilities. Rich mahogany joinery and Alcantara upholstery create a refined atmosphere, while the layout remains functional for extended living aboard.

The galley is well equipped for cruising, and ample refrigeration supports longer stays on board. Heating adds comfort in cooler climates, making this Janmor 45CL suitable for a wide range of cruising grounds and seasons. Storage and living space have been carefully considered, giving her the feel of a true passagemaker.

On deck, she is equally well prepared. An electric windlass, multiple anchors, full cockpit protection, and a comprehensive cruising inventory complete the package. She offers the space, equipment, and capability that discerning sailors expect from a serious ocean-going yacht.

This Janmor 45CL is a rare opportunity to acquire a well-equipped, ocean-ready cruiser with excellent autonomy, comfortable accommodation, and proven bluewater credentials.
