Dufour 412 Grand Large built 2019 from the boards of Felci Yacht Design. A fast and modern aft cockpit cruising yacht with attractive lines and Dufour's innovative features. GRP hull and structure with teak covering the cockpit, aft sections of seating and the drop down stern platform.

Powered by 40hp Volvo D2-40F, sail drive unit to 2 bladed folding prop. Elvstrom Sails (main/genoa 2019), full Raymarine navigation equipment incl A50D plotter/GPS/Orca.

Accom for 6/8 in 3 double cabins + 2 in saloon, 2 Jabsco heads and showers, light wood joinered interior, spacious saloon with main seating to port, seating and navigation table stbd, galley aft to stb opposite main heads. Holding tanks, hot water calorifier.
