This 2006 Beneteau Oceanis 50 combines elegant design with dependable performance, making her an excellent choice for both coastal cruising and extended passages. Designed by Berret-Racoupeau and built by Beneteau, she offers a perfect balance of comfort, capability, and ease of handling. A spacious cockpit with twin helms and a sugar scoop transom makes sailing efficient and relaxing, whether underway or at anchor.

Her owner's version layout provides a desirable arrangement for long-term living aboard. The forward master cabin includes a private ensuite, while two generous aft cabins welcome family or guests. A bright saloon, full navigation station, and L-shaped galley create a practical yet inviting space. Warm joinery, off-white upholstery, and Webasto heating ensure comfort in all climates.

The yacht is powered by a reliable Yanmar 100hp engine with only 1,200 hours. Systems are designed to support extended cruising, including six solar panels and a Lewmar electric windlass. Sail handling has been modernized with a roller furling genoa and stack-pack mainsail, making her easy to manage shorthanded.

Maintained in excellent condition, this Beneteau Oceanis 50 is fully equipped and ready to sail. She represents a rare opportunity to step aboard a proven, well-prepared cruising yacht.
