Boat Description

Hunter 430 built in **1997**, designed by **Warren Luhrs**. This spacious cruising yacht features a bulb/wing keel and wheel steering. It is powered by a **Volvo MD22P 50hp engine**, equipped with a **Max Power Bowthruster** and a **Lugger Genset**. The mainsail was replaced in **2014**, and the standing rigging was also updated in **2014**. Accommodations for 6 are available in **2 cabins** plus the saloon. The yacht includes air conditioning units both fore and aft, and two holding tanks. It is well-equipped for liveaboard cruising, with ample navigation and safety gear. The yacht has been in private British ownership since **2008** and is priced at **£49,900**.

Yacht has a berth with lease until May 2028 available for the new owner to take benefit of. There is no charge for this, it is included in the sale. Does not include water/electricity or maintenance costs.
