Powered by 110hp Yanmar 4JH4- HTE engine (1410 hrs), Bowthruster. Large battery bank and solar array suitable for extended periods at anchor, Solar arch with integrated dinghy davits.

Standing rigging replaced 2024 , Fully battened mainsail. Full complement of sun shades, covers and cockpit cushions, Highfield tender with 9.9hp Yamaha outboard.
