Innovative cockpit area, the twin helms and winches are positioned far aft resulting in the cockpit becoming a space haven.

Highly specified from factory with Electric secondary winch, multiple Chart plotters, Electric and key fob remote control operated swim platform, reclining cockpit coamings for ultimate Catamaran style outdoor living space. Full cockpit enclosure with multiple options for shade, sun, wind and spray shelter. Has the larger 57hp engine, Bow thruster, anchor windlass with chain counter with operation from helm or foredeck. An extra water tank doubles the onboard capacity for peace of mind and encourages enjoyment of deck shower on swim platform with hot and cold water.

On top of the fantastic standard spec the owners added extra equipment for autonomy and comfort. 1. Very large capacity (low profile as neatly installed) 1290kw high efficiency solar array. 2. Total of 1000Ah AGM leisure battery. 3. 2500watt inverter.

These 3 items enable all navigation systems to run without need of engine alternator input on long passages. Continuous off grid capability – use of Fridge/freezer, cooking with induction,

electric kettle, toaster, microwave. Continuous use of Starlink Internet and TV with predict wind, BBC I player, youtube etc.

Other extras include Webasto diesel heating and mobile air con unit.

Best features unique to the new sun odyssey 440 are in the innovation of the cockpit. The helm and winches are positioned far aft resulting in the cockpit becoming a haven for the children especially secure and comfortable while underway. The adaptable space has so many details and tricks up its sleeve. Learn about this and you will understand one of the reasons why the owners didn't want to compromise with any other boat.

Other neat features are easy stowage of a dinghy and outboard in rear helm locker and the easy inflation and launch from the swim platform.
